Austrian-American Day USA

In 1997, after many years of successful community and humanitarian work, the Austrian-American Councils of North America sent a petition to the President of the United States, the U.S. Senate, and all 50 Governors requesting September 26th be officially designated "National Austrian-American Day". Then-President Bill Clinton, with the unanimous consent of the Senate and Governors, issued a Presidential Proclamation affirming the request. Austrian-American Day is celebrated nationally with various festivities on or close to that date. An Annual Award, composed of Patron donations, net proceeds from the event, plus a gift from the Council itself, was created by the Austrian-American Council West to be donated to a carefully selected nonprofit organization that focuses on the welfare, nurturing, and education of children. Past recipients include City of Hope, Children's Hospital Los Angeles, Good Shepherd Center for Homeless Women and Children, Hollygrove Home for Children, Recording for the Blind and Dyslexic (now Learning Ally), Kidspace Children's Museum, SOS Children's Villages, and more.



About Los Angeles Children's Chorus

Los Angeles Children's Chorus provides choral music education of the highest quality to young people who represent richly diverse racial, economic, and cultural backgrounds, bringing the transformative power of music to communities throughout Southern California, the nation, and the world. Now celebrating its 26th season, LACC, under artistic director Anne Tomlinson, performs frequently with Los Angeles Philharmonic, Hollywood Bowl Orchestra, and Los Angeles Master Chorale among others, and also trains and provides children for Los Angeles Opera productions. LACC has toured more than 14 countries, most recently South Africa. While in Vienna, the Chorus sang with the Florianer Saengerknaben at St. Florian's Abbey and participated in an evening concert with the Vienna Boys Choir.
